ANSWERS: A: They didn't play each other. B: It wasn't raining. C: 2nd place. If you pass the person in the first place, you'd be in the first place.

A rope tied to a bull's neck is 10 feet long and his food trough is 15 feet away. How did the bull eat successfully without breaking the rope or cutting it?



A rooster laid an egg on top of the barn roof. Which way did it roll?

ANSWERS: A: Meat. B: Walked over. The rope wasn't tied to anything beyon the bull's neck. C: It didn't roll as roosters don't lay eggs. Hens do.





A plane crashes on the border of the U.S. and Canada. Where do they bury the survivors?



If you have three, you have three. If you have two, you have two. But, if you have one, you have none. What is it?



A barrel of water weighs 60 pounds. What must you put in it for it to weigh 40 pounds?

ANSWERS: A: You don't bury survivors...only the dead. B: Choices. C: A hole.
